The project later received funding through the Australian Department of Defence and TeraText has subsequently been used by Defence and the Australian Intelligence Community.

In addition to supporting National Security, Leidos Australia has also developed the product to support drafting and publishing complex legislation documents.

Locally, TeraText is used in the Federal Parliament, Parliamentary Counsels in New South Wales, Queensland, and Tasmania, as well as the Australian Tax Office. Globally, it is used in Canada, United States and Singapore.
