Dr. Kosiak continues to serve in the Army National Guard as an emergency physician. He currently holds the position of State Surgeon for the South Dakota Army National Guard. He is a decorated officer having served three tours of duty in support of Operation Iraqi and Enduring Freedom.

"Dr. Kosiak brings strong leadership and significant clinical expertise," said Leidos Health and Engineering Sector President, Jon Scholl. "Don is a perfect fit at Leidos, having medical, technical and military experience.
