### Cybersecurity Expert to Lead the Assurance, Integration and Manufacturing Operation

Harwood will lead the Assurance, Integration and Manufacturing Operation (AIMO) supporting the cyber market under the Integrated Systems Group (ISG). Harwood is certified Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act Level III in Program Management and is a member of the NSA Acquisition Corps.
