



Leidos Engineering to Support U.S. Navy, Marine Corps Military Aircraft

\$50M aircraft home basing contract includes environmental and related mission operations support

(Reston, Va.) April 6, 2015 – Leidos Engineering was awarded a prime contract from the Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC) Atlantic to provide environmental planning and mission operations support for U.S. Navy and Marine Corps aircraft. The single-award, indefinite delivery indefinite quantity (IDIQ) contract has a potential value of \$50 million over the five year performance period ending in 2020.

Under the contract, Leidos will manage complex National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation for proposed infrastructure-related actions with respect to aircraft home basing issues. The company's responsibilities will also include analysis of home basing of aircraft; construction, renovation and demolition services of airfield facilities and infrastructure; base realignment and closure actions; and proposed operational actions related to aircraft home basing. The primary geographic regions for contract tasks are NAVFAC Atlantic's Area of Responsibility (AOR) and adjacent waters in the U.S., Caribbean, Europe and North Africa, but tasks may be assigned anywhere in the world.
