In addition, the contract includes sustainment of the accredited Base-Level Support Application FuelsManager® Defense, FuelsManager® Defense – Express and FuelsManager® Defense Enterprise software to correct existing processes and to assist with continued interface sustainment between Business Systems Modernization – Energy and eConvergence.
