The single-award time and material (T&M) contract has a three-year period of performance and a total contract value of \$55 million. The agreement covers work Leidos will perform to help business and residential customers save energy through Ameren Illinois's ActOnEnergy® portfolio of energy efficiency solutions.



Since 2008, Leidos has implemented a broad range of award-winning efficiency programs for Ameren Illinois's commercial and industrial customers.
