



Leidos Awarded Contract by Boston Properties and Konterra Realty

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Technical Solutions Company to Provide IT, Security and Facilities Support

The company, formerly named Science Applications International Corporation, changed its name to Leidos, Inc. on September 27, 2013 in connection with the spin-off of its former technical, engineering and enterprise information technology business, which has assumed the company's former name.
