



## Leidos Awarded Contract By Washington Headquarters Services

### Solutions Company to Provide Professional Engineering and Technical Support Services for Corrosion Prevention and Control

RESTON, Va., Nov. 6, 2013 /PRNewswire/ -- Leidos [NYSE: LDOS], an engineering, national security and health solutions company announced it was awarded a prime contract by Washington Headquarters Services (WHS) to provide engineering and technical support services to the Department of Defense (DoD) Corrosion Prevention and Mitigation Program. The multiple-award blanket purchase agreement has a one-year period of performance, four option years, and a total contract value ceiling of approximately \$50 million for all awardees, if all competitive options are exercised. Work will be performed in Washington, D.C. and the surrounding metro area.

Under the contract, the Leidos team will provide the DoD Corrosion Prevention and Mitigation Program with a wide range of acquisition, policy, sustaining engineering and technical support services across the program's focus areas, which include the following: Policy and Oversight; Communications and Outreach; Specifications, Standards, and Qualification Process; Metrics, Impact, and Sustainment; Science and Technology; Training and Certification; and Facilities. Leidos is one of four contractors eligible to compete for task orders under the BPA award.

WHS is the essential services provider for the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD), DoD agencies, and offices in the National Capital Region. WHS provides a wide range of centralized capabilities to DoD headquarters, OSD, and DoD components, enabling economies of scale for delivering essential administrative services to fulfill the mission of the Department. WHS is aligned under the Director of Administration and Management for OSD.

"We recognize the severe impact corrosion can have on military equipment and infrastructure, so we look forward to providing our technical and policy expertise to help with corrosion prevention, control, and mitigation activities across the DoD," said James R. Moos, Leidos group president.

The company, formerly named Science Applications International Corporation, changed its name to Leidos, Inc. on September 27, 2013 in connection with the spin-off of its former technical, engineering and enterprise information technology business, which has assumed the company's former name. Leidos has submitted a change-of-name agreement to the U.S. government to recognize the name change, which is currently under review by the responsible Defense Contract Management Agency contracting officer.
