The award was presented yesterday to SAIC's Brad Hornburg, managing director, and Mike Gwyn, president of Benham Constructors, at the DBIA's 2010 Conference and Expo in Las Vegas, Nev.

Grumski, SAIC senior vice president and business unit general manager. "It's wonderful to see Dr Pepper producing its products just one year after purchasing the property."
