Company Among Recipients of the Hoyt S. Vandenberg Award

(McLEAN, Va.) Sept. 15, 2010 -- Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC) [NYSE: SAI] today announced it will receive the Air Force Association's (AFA) highest honor in the field of aerospace education - the Hoyt S. Vandenberg Award.

The award, established in 1948, will be presented to Larry Cox, SAIC senior vice president and business unit general manager, during the Air and Space Conference and Technology Expo held Sept. 13-15 in Washington, D.C.

The award honors outstanding achievements of men and women throughout the Air Force, government, academia and aerospace industry. SAIC shares the award with the University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA) for its founding partnership and Northrop Grumman for its presenting sponsorship of *CyberPatriot*, the national high school cyber defense competition designed to excite, educate and motivate the next generation of cyber defenders, and other science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) graduates.

The *CyberPatriot* competition is powered by SAIC's patent pending CyberNEXS cyber security trainer that provides a live cyber environment, in which students have to maintain critical services, while responding to real-world hacker attacks. Over the years, SAIC has voluntarily worked closely with AFA and UTSA to continue to improve CyberNEXS functionality and capacity in support of AFA vision to reach schools nationwide. Last year, SAIC supported hundreds of teams over the Internet leveraging common IT and security hardware; this year's goal is 1,000 teams.

"We are honored to receive this award for our support of *CyberPatriot*," said Cox, who was recently named to the *CyberPatriot* board of advisors. "Our nation faces a real challenge in ensuring our youth are inspired and prepared for an ever more cyber-connected economy requiring a new level of cyber readiness, vigilance and security. We applaud the AFA on their *CyberPatriot* vision and commitment to create the largest and fastest-growing high school cyber defense competition."
