



SAIC Awarded Blanket Purchase Agreement to Support U.S. Environmental Protection Agency

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Company to Provide Comprehensive Information Technology Infrastructure Support Services to the Office of Environmental Information

The BPA was awarded under the Information Technology Solutions-Environmental Protection Agency II contract, and has a seven-year period of performance, and a ceiling value of \$955 million for all awardees. Work will be performed under the direction of EPA's Office of Technology Operations and Planning.

EPA's OEI is responsible for the management and implementation of a secure IT infrastructure, and provides the agency with IT solutions to support mission success. Under the BPA, SAIC will compete to provide a broad range of support services as required in areas including call center and application deployment management; network and user support; geospatial services; and IT security.

"We look forward to providing IT services and solutions to support EPA as they advance the creation, management and use of information as a strategic resource by providing critical IT services and products," said Doug Wagoner, SAIC senior vice president and business unit general manager.
