Under a new three-year, \$127 million contract, Leidos will continue to administer the [Hawai'i Energy](#) program and the state's Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Station Rebate program, while also overseeing market solutions, educational initiatives, and training efforts.

"Hawai'i continues to be a leader in encouraging its residents and businesses to make practical energy-saving decisions and reduce energy use," said Bill Johnson, senior vice president, Energy, Infrastructure and Automation at Leidos. "With each main island generating its own power, efficiency and resiliency are critical. By lowering energy demand and improving efficiency, Leidos helps strengthen the state's energy independence and long-term energy security. Leidos has administered the Hawai'i Energy program since 2009. Since then, Hawai'i Energy has delivered more than \$7 billion in energy savings statewide. In the most recent program year alone, it distributed over 18,000 rebates totaling approximately \$20 million.

The continued partnership reflects Leidos' broader commitment to advancing energy efficiency, grid modernization, and resilience through collaboration with utilities nationwide. It also aligns with Leidos' NorthStar 2030 strategic focus on energy infrastructure.
